May 6–7, 2008 in Stockholm

This international symposium on prehospital care is one in the series of Berzelius symposia. The will focus on prehospital care, which plays an important role within the modern emergency medicine care.

Early preventive measures and precise action which should be taken when somebody has got a trauma, stroke or heartdisease is of decisive importance. The importance of time has been expressed during the latest decades in terms of »the golden minutes« at many acute diseases.

However, the decision whether to transport the patient immediately or start treatment prehospitally varies when treating for example acute myocardial infarction patients (should we stay and play?) or trauma patients (should we scoop and run?) The purpose of prehospital care is at a early stage

 \cdot to appoint the right measures for various diseases

• to create a durable (lasting) robust chain of treatment. From the patient \rightarrow scene of incident \rightarrow the dispatching \rightarrow ambulance to the emergency room and hospital treatment.

We have got a high level of medical competence as regards the prehospital care in Sweden. The ambition regarding the care of the patient prior to hospital care is to establish plans of action and care of the patient based upon evidencebased treatment which also characterize the entire health care section.

The purpose of the symposium is to illustrate new oppurtunities, difficulties and international experiences within this field. The first day will focus on trauma and the second day will deal with internalmedical aspects; stroke, heart attack and cardiac arrest.

We have invited wellknown international and Swedish doctors who will discuss future developments and new aspects of how to obtain the goal of safe and effective prehospital care.

The meeting is to attract scientists and clinicians from various different areas with interest in and connection to prehospital care.

The symposium will be held in the centrally located beautiful 19th century building of the Swedish Society of Medicine.
